
Appendix C.6.2 - Government benefits Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to first review for SF - by participant characteristics






Appendix C.6.2 - Government benefits Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to first review for SF - by participant characteristics (continued)






Appendix C.6.3 - Rights and advocacy Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to first review for SF - by participant characteristics






Appendix C.6.4 - Families feel supported Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to first review for LF - by participant characteristics








Appendix C.6.5 - Access to services Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to first review for SF - by participant characteristics








Appendix C.6.5 - Access to services Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to first review for LF - by participant characteristics


















Appendix C.6.8 - Families enjoy health and wellbeing Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to first review for LF - by participant characteristics



Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to second review for SF - by participant characteristics






Appendix C.7.5 - Access to services Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to second review for SF - by participant characteristics








Appendix C.8.3 - Rights and advocacy Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to third review for SF - by participant characteristics






Appendix C.8.4 - Families feel supported Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to third review for LF - by participant characteristics






Appendix C.8.5 - Access to services Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to third review for SF - by participant characteristics






Appendix C.8.6 - Families help their young person become independent Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to third review for SF - by participant characteristics









Appendix C.8.8 - Families have succession plans Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to third review for SF - by participant characteristics





